Dr. BRIJ LAL GUPTA

Born in Sangat, Bhatinda district, had medical education in Lahore, GS Medical College and KEM Hospital, Mumbai, after Partition. MBBS in 1951, he did his MS and FRCS, had training in cardiothoracic surgery. He developed the cardiothoracic surgery departments in St Georges Hospital, Nanavati Hospital, but also in peripheral hospitals like Sarvodaya Hospital, Sewri TB Hospital, Watumal Chest Hospital, Western and Central Railway Hospitals; and in various places in Madhya Pradesh. He helped in developing an ethical kidney transplant programme in Nanavati Hospital. Playing a significant role in the creation of the Indian Association of Cardio-Thoracic Surgeons, and helped to hold its first Meeting in Mumbai in 1970. He became its President in 1989-90. His memoirs," Straight from the Heart" have been published, to coincide with the golden jubilee of the first open heart surgery, on 15th February, 2011, just a month before he died. IACTs gracefully noted the sad demise of one of its past presidents Dr. B.L. Gupta on 13th March, 2011. He is survived by his wife Dr. Torulata, Sons Dr. Rajan, Sudhir and daughter Sangeetha. A condolence letter has been sent to the family on behalf of the association from Secretary's Office.
