#### **ORATIONS**

The rules governing the nominations are as follows.

- The C.S Sadasivan Memorial Oration shall pertain to Cardiac Surgery, while the Godrej S Karai Memorial Oration shall pertain to General Thoracic and / or Vascular Surgery.
- The nominee for the Orations shall be a Member / Life member /fellow / overseas member / overseas life member of at least seven years standing.

  - a) A detailed curriculum vitae of the nominee.
  - b) A brief note regarding the contribution of the nominee towards the advancement for cardiac surgery (for Sadasivan Oration) or General Thoracic / Vascular surgery (for Godrej S Karai Memorial Oration).
  - An indication from the nominee regarding his/her willingness to deliver the Oration, if selected.

#### **REEVE H BETTS FELLOWSHIP**

Applications are invited for the award of two Reeve H Betts Fellowships. The conditions governing the fellowship are:

# Obituary

## Tribute to Dr. Madhuri Nigam

Heart-mender with a Golden Soul (18.9.1945 - 16.8.2007)




Dr Madhuri Nigam, former Director-Professor and Head, Cardiothoracic Surgery, GB Part Hospital New Delhi was born on 18 September 1945. With her demise on August 16, 2007, the fraternity of cardiothoracic vascular surgeons of India, has lost one of its pioneering lady cardiac surgeons.

Daughter of the illustrious surgeon-teacher-counsellor late Professor Ramesh Nigam, Dr Madnuri Nigam was a 1964-batch alumnus of Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi. She completed her surgical post-graduation under the tutelage of Professor Sandeep Mukerjee at Lady Hardinge Medical College. She obtained her postdoctoral degree in paediatric surgery at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences where her mentor, Dr Purushottam Upadhyaya discovered her overwhelming interest in cardiac ailments of children, and wholeheartedly encouraged her to merge her training into the realm of cardiac surgery. This prompted her to train for two years at some of the Meccas of cardiac surgery in London, such as the Hospital for Sick Children at Great Ormonde Street; the Harefield Hospital and the Royal Brompton Hospital. In 1980, she returned to India and joined the Govind Ballabh Pant Hospital as a lecturer in cardiothoracic surgery. She superannuated in 2005 at the end of a highly fruitful and rewarding academic career.

The greatness of Professor Nigam lay in her unique capacity to empathise with anyone she came in contact with, as her very own. Thus all those who knew her, fondly remember her as an integral member of their own private world. Her family adored her as a daughter, consort and mother extraordinaire. Her students revered her as a teacher and a guide par excellence. Her colleagues will forever miss her as the lady with a heart that would reach out with many a helping hand at their difficult times. Her patients saw in her an angel with a golden soul everbrimming with the nectars of mercy and benevolence.

A hardcore workaholic, Dr Madhuri Nigam almost refused to believe anyone could disturb work on account of sickness. She sought output measurable in geometric proportions. Her rare skill of completing double-valve replacements with just 20 minutes of cross-clamp times left the assisting residents gasping for breath! As Chairperson of the Scientific Programme Committee, the clockwork precision and competence with which she conduced the scientific sessions of the 42nd Annual Conference of IACTS along with the Centenary Celebration of Cardiac Surgery remains hard to emulate.

Professor Madhuri Nigam is survived by her husband, Mr Ranvir Sinha, son Ashok, scores of students, hundreds of admirers and those who were benefitted by her kindness, and a legacy which the cardiothoracic surgeons of this country can feel proud of.
