Dr. Patrick Perier, MD, Cardiac Surgeon in division of cardiac surgery at Herz und Gefäss Klink (Bad Neustadt/Saale), Germany. Dr. Perier trained and graduated for heart and vascular Surgery from the Hôpital Broussais in Paris, under the supervision of Alain Carpentier who became his mentor. He was the first who compared the long-term results of mitral valve repair and mitral valve replacement. He initiated mitral valve reconstruction in Germany taking part in its increasing popularity. He further developed techniques of mitral valve repair, with a specific interest in dealing with prolapse of the posterior leaflet. During the last 10 years he has concentrated in developing video-assisted mitral valve surgery with increasing enthusiasm. Today more than 1500 patients have had minimally invasive reconstruction of the mitral valve.
