2025 Elections

A warm invitation to the 2025 Elections to apply for the offices of the IACTS which will be held during the 71st Annual Conference of the Indian Association of Cardiovascular-Thoracic Surgeons,

IACTSCON 2025 in Delhi on 21st February, 2025

Voting shall be by secret ballot, to be held during the Annual General Body Meeting where each voter shall cast his vote by marking 'X' against the name of each of the contestant / contestants of his/her choice for any of the posts. The Senior Vice-President shall be the Returning Officer for the election.

In the event of the decision of the Returning Officer for the elections of the Executive Committee with regard to the validity of the nominations and votes and the results of the said elections, is reversed or set aside by the President, the General Body shall immediately appoint a panel of three members chosen from those attending the said General Body Meeting. The President shall then adjourn the Annual General Body for 15 minutes, if required, or longer, at the end of which the said panel shall give its verdict which shall be binding on all parties.
